What do you say to a charming rustic getaway - just a bit far from home? Head to Punjabiyat, a luxury lodge that will give you a taste of living in a traditional Punjabi village but with all modern amenities. About an hour's drive from Amritsar, Punjabiyat is set amidst lush farmlands and offers four cottages each with an en suite bathroom, a front deck and a private terrace. You could visit the local *mandi* and the *gurdwara* close by, explore the countryside on a bicycle or tractor and even try your hand at cooking a Punjabi meal. You can also make a trip to Amritsar or to Maharana Pratap Sagar Sanctuary that's just 50km away. Prices start from Rs 3,500 per person per night on twin sharing basis and include accommodation, breakfast and taxes. You can get a discount of 15 per cent if you book for four days or more. And if you book three cottages, you get the fourth gratis. The lodge can arrange for airport/railway station transfer (from Amritsar) for an additional cost.
